EMSA – Sulphur Inspection Guidance

The European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) has posted its Sulphur Inspection Guidance for use by EC Port State Control Officers enforcing compliance with Council Directive 1999/32/EC as amended regarding the sulphur content of liquid fuels (the "Sulphur Directive").

The Sulphur Committee held on the 6th of May 2015 adopted the Guidelines as the reference document for a harmonized enforcement of the Sulphur Directive.
